3. RALLY START LOCATION

Ref Final Instructions #1, Section 11: Please remember that the event will start from **MCO** at the Otter Pool Car Park on the Raiders Road, which is 8.45miles away from the Service Area.

The first car will leave **MCO** at **10:20**, and other cars will follow at 1 minute intervals.

Competitors are reminded that they need to attend Noise Check at the Service Area Exit, before heading to MCO. **Cars should arrive at Noise Check approximately 30-40 minutes before their due time at MCO.**

4. CHICANE PENALTIES

A **blatant non-attempt** at a chicane will be penalised at **30 seconds per offence**.

For clarity: a non-attempt, involves substantial damage or rearrangement of the chicane location by the competitor vehicle. The decision of the Judge of Fact at the location will be final.
